We are pleased to offer in-home ABA programs for:

-  Military families with a child with ASD ages 2-7 (if your child is over 7 contact the Knapp Center to determine if your child is eligible)
-  Open to families across the U.S. and overseas
-  Requirements: Computer, Internet connection, Tri-care Insurance

HOW DOES THE PROGRAM WORK?

-  An adult in your area will be trained in ABA through the Knapp Center
-  ABA tutor will work with your child one-on-one delivering ABA services in your home
-  ABA tutors will work under the supervision of a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) from the Knapp Center
-  Services will be provided weekly through the Knapp Center via an internet based video conferencing site (with the occasional visit to the child's home by the BCBA)






WHAT CAN ABA OFFER?

-  Learn new academic and adaptive functioning skills
-  Reduce disruptive behaviors
-  Increase communication and social skills
